## Advanced Diploma (26 Credits)

Freshmen Entering SY 2018-2019 and Beyond

All Graduation Requirements are set forth by the Virginia Department of Education

COURSE	CREDITS	VERIFIED CREDITS*	DESCRIPTION
ENGLISH	4	2	Courses shall include English 9, 10, 11, and 12 or an advanced equivalent.
MATHEMATICS	4	1	All students must take one Math SOL in High School (if a student passes a math SOL in Middle School, per federal requirement they must sit for a math SOL in High School)
SCIENCE	4	1	Must take Biology and Biology SOL
SOCIAL STUDIES	4	1	Courses shall include U.S. and Virginia History, U.S. and Virginia Government, World Geography, and World History II.
HEALTH & PE	2		
ECONOMICS AND PERSONAL FINANCE	1		
WORLD LANGUAGE	3 or 4		Courses shall include three years of one language or two years each of two languages.
ELECTIVES	4		Credits earned for this requirement shall include one credit in fine arts, world language, or CTE. Courses shall also include two electives of which are sequential. World Language cannot count as the sequential elective unless three years of one language and 2 years of another are taken.
